1. **Job title and number of positions:** Project Associate Professor or Project Lecturer. Two in total.

3. **Research interests:** Condensed matter physics, quantum information and quantum electronics, and nanoscience

The research is under the UTokyo-National Research and Development Agency Corporation program, “Emergent Matter Science”.
